

# 2019 Suggested Supply List for Juniors for Digital Design & Print Technology

THE FOLLOWING SUPPLY'S ARE NOT INCLUDED IN ANY FEES.

- Small Art bin with lock. This can be a small tool box or tackle box.



This tool box is \$9.00 at Home Depot. It does have a place/holes for a lock.

PLEASE NOTE - If it is a large art bin, it will not fit in lockers or cubby.

- 1 1/2 inch standard 3 ring binder with pockets. *(no dividers needed)*
- Inexpensive paper portfolio
  - approx. \$10.00 at Hobby Lobby or Michaels. Can be any color.



- 2 - 32GB Flash Drives *(Amazon sale has 2 pack under \$20.00)*
- Safety goggles with side splash guard or a wrap around lens.
- X-Acto knife with cap (standard)
- 2 or 3 Glue Sticks
- Erasers - White Vinyl recommended
- Sissors
- 2 fine and 2 standard black Sharpies
- Color Pencils - A pouch for pencils work best for the art bins.  
*(sets for adult coloring books work very well and have a great assortment of colors)*
- Standard 12 or 15 inch stanless ruler with non slip cork back
- Ear buds or head phones.

\*\* Please Note - If you are on free or reduced lunch, check with Mrs. Thoburn for a donated tool bin while they last.

For **SAFETY**, Open toe shoes are NEVER permitted anywhere in lab.
